- Ownership details
- Project description
- Supervising consultants with registration numbers
- Contractors (main and sub-contractor)
- Statutory approval numbers

- Hard hats
- Safety glasses
- Earplugs
- Gloves
- Safety shoes or boots



Display of relevant licenses and approved drawings at the site office



Safety signage throughout the site




Fall protection systems:
